God was with Joseph and gave him wisdom and a special gift—the ability to understand dreams. Even when he was treated unfairly and thrown into prison, God never left him. A good plan was unfolding, even when it didn't look that way.

When Pharaoh had troubling dreams no one could explain, God helped Joseph understand them. Everything changed at once. He was taken from prison and made a powerful leader, second only to Pharaoh. Joseph ordered that food be stored across Egypt so the people would survive the coming famine.

When hunger spread, Joseph's brothers came to Egypt for food. They did not recognise the ruler before them, dressed in fine clothes and full of authority.

Seeing them stirred many emotions. There was power to punish, but instead their hearts were tested. When they chose what was right, tears filled his eyes. He revealed who he was, forgave them, and God used his story to save many lives.

Hidden Messages!

Discover how things we cannot see can still be there!



Can you write a message that nobody can see?

Just as Daniel chose to obey God even when others could not see what was in his heart, this experiment reveals a hidden message!

We're going to use lemon juice to create invisible ink and discover whether something hidden can suddenly appear.

You will need:

- White paper
- Lemon juice
- Small bowl
- Cotton bud or small paintbrush
- Hairdryer or lamp
- An adult helper



Steps to Try:

1. Pour a little lemon juice into a small bowl.
2. Dip a cotton bud into the juice.
3. Write a secret message on white paper.
4. Let the paper dry completely.
5. Look carefully. Can you still see your message?
6. Ask an adult to help warm the paper using a hairdryer or lamp.
7. Watch closely as your hidden message begins to appear!

💡 Will your message stay hidden forever, or will it suddenly appear?

YOU WILL NEED:



Coloured paper or card



Scissors



Crayons, pencils, or markers



Glue or tape



Hole punch (optional)



String or ribbon



Ruler



HOW TO MAKE YOUR WISDOM GARDEN

1 Create Your Garden Base

Cut a large rectangle from card or thick paper. This will be the background for your garden.



2 Make Garden Pieces

Cut out different garden shapes such as:

- Leaves
- Flowers
- Vegetables
- Seedlings
- Roots



3 Decorate Each Piece

Colour your garden pieces using bright colours.

Add patterns, details, and designs to make each piece unique.



4 Add Wise Character Traits

Write one word on each garden piece:

- Wisdom
- Integrity
- Honesty
- Kindness
- Patience
- Faithfulness
- Obedience



5 Build Your Garden

Arrange your pieces on the garden base. Place roots near the bottom, plants in the middle, and flowers or leaves near the top.

When you are happy with your design, glue everything down.



6 Add a Heading

Create a title for your garden. Ideas:

- Growing in Wisdom
- God's Wisdom Garden
- Wise Choices Grow Here



7 Add a Hanging Ribbon

Punch two holes near the top corners. Thread ribbon or string through the holes and tie the ends.



8 Display Your Garden

Hang your Wisdom Garden somewhere you will see it often. Each time you look at it, remember that God can help you grow in wisdom and integrity every day.
